Penal Code 11166.5 requires all persons defined as “child care custodians” to sign a statement to the effect that they understand and will comply with their legal obligation to report known or suspected instances of child abuse.

Sexual Harassment

Title VII of the Civil Right Acts of 1964, regulatory guidelines of the Equal Opportunity Commission, California Law and Regional District Board Policy as well as Title IX of the Education Amendments Acts of 1964 prohibits Sexual Harassment of students, by students and adults. Obligations exist for the mandatory reporting of all suspected instances of sexual harassment “teachers in a classroom setting shall take action to stop any harassment of students . . . any employee receiving such a charge or complaint is directed to deliver it to the Superintendent immediately.”
